


Communities and Connection Across the South Salish Sea

Course Description: “Salish Sea Landscapes and Waterscapes” is a 4-credit course that focuses on areas of modern western Washington including Puget Sound, the Strait of Juan de Fuca, and the surrounding watersheds. Students will examine contemporary political, social, and environmental issues, such as Tribal and federal/state/provincial governmental relations, economic and urban development, and the impact of global climate change. In order to explore these interrelated topics, this course will investigate the complex histories of peoples’ ever-changing relationships with their surroundings in the Salish Sea region.
