Latest Masking Guidance

Our current guidelines as described below are in accordance with the [July 27 CDC guidance](#) following a surge in some areas of the Delta variant.

- Masks are still required in common spaces, regardless of vaccination status (hallways, restrooms, foyers, etc.)
- Those work, study, or activity groups that are fully vaccinated and verified may be unmasked in their enclosed work or study space.
- Masks are still required for anyone unvaccinated
- Masks are no longer required outdoors, regardless of vaccination status. Those who are not vaccinated should understand they remain at high risk of infection and should wear masks when in close proximity to others or in crowds.
- Unvaccinated individuals may eat indoors without masks, where they can socially distance, but will be safest when eating alone or outside.
