Update from last meeting

- Flu registration on evergreen.edu/flu is not anonymous, but names are kept confidential

Accident Reports

- Nothing too bad; not trip and fall season yet
- Incomplete; next meeting will cover rest of October and November

LNI Training

- Supervisors are required to train employees; initial training and follow-up training
- Robyn can provide general training, but supervisors should provide specific training
 - She also has training matrix for when/how often employees should be trained
- Robyn will ask at next staff meeting (or email) to figure out where Facilities is at with their trainings

Flu Report

- So far 53 students and 9 faculty/staff have registered online as having flu
 - 16 reports this week alone
- Health Center doing triage at clinic
 - Seeing roughly 3-30 people a day
 - Not testing all
- Last 2 flu clinics
 - 100 H1N1 vaccines
 - 57 seasonal flu vaccines
 - 10 seasonal flu vaccines (under 18 yrs old)
- Next flu clinic Monday, Nov. 9th
 - 100 doses of each vaccine available and on-hand
 - Can serve roughly 75 students per clinic (depending on number of staff/students that show up)
- Faculty/staff clinic?

- Students should call clinic if feeling ill and should only go to clinic if they have high fever (should really go to doctor/hospital at that point)

Knives on-campus
