  - The system was proven effective at the Childcare Center. There were mixed results in the residential complex. The message was intelligible outdoors. Indoors, not so much. A subgroup continues to review protocols regarding the use of Giant Voice. The system will not suffice as our only means of dual indoor/outdoor mass-notification. Messages, along with overall usage, will need to cater to those who are outdoors. I.E.-“Attention! Armed and dangerous person alert. Seek a secure location, lock doors, close windows. Wait until further notice.”
- Discussed the possibility of relocating the Sem 1 smoking tent
  - Members who were present recommended that the tent remain in its current location. Topic tabled for further discussion.
