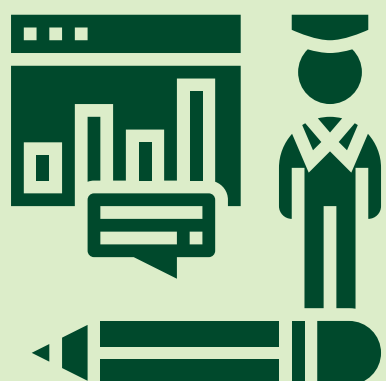

LEARNING MANAGEMENT SYSTEM (LMS): CANVAS

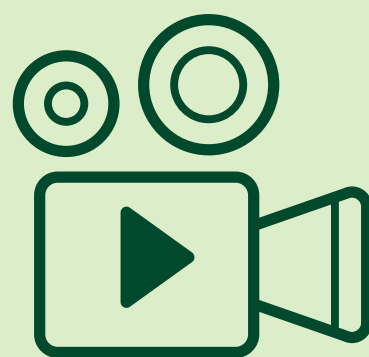


The LMS is a students point of entry into learning and should act as a container for all course content, communication and feedback. This is the digital home for online learning and is the place students will go to find course content, meetings, discussions, feedback and communications. Even if you use other platforms/technologies, everything should be anchored here.

ASYNCHRONOUS VIDEO: ZOOM

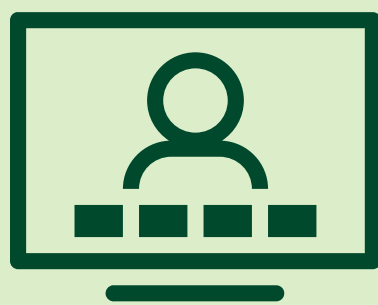
The recommended approach for recording videos to share with students is through zoom. Another good option is to record audio narration using PowerPoint.

Pro Tip: Keep all “new” learning to asynchronous work and reserve synchronous time for processing and applying learning. This means that lectures, readings, films, and other content that students consume for the first time should be offered asynchronously, so the learner has sufficient time to review the material prior to “putting it into practice” in the classroom.



SYNCHRONOUS VIDEO: ZOOM

Evergreen provides all faculty with a ZoomPro license, a videoconferencing software that offers a robust set of tools for hosting and managing synchronous class sessions. ZoomPro is integrated into Canvas, which enables faculty to seamlessly schedule sessions.



COLLABORATIVE FILE DEVELOPMENT/ SHARING: O365

Evergreen faculty, staff and students have Microsoft Office 365 accounts, which allows users to create, share and collaborate on documents with each other in real time.

Collaborative documents allows for shared ownership of work, instant communication, and increased cooperation.
