## Master of Public Administration – 60 TOTAL credits required to graduate

Admission requirements (refer to your admissions letter)

- Provisional** – submit final, official transcripts with bachelor’s degree earned to Graduate Admissions
- Conditional** – Internship required *before* graduation

### MPA Core Courses (36 credits)

- Core courses must be taken sequentially.
- **Students must complete a minimum of 40 credits prior to taking Capstone.**
  - **Capstone** is only offered in the Spring.

### MPA Concentration – Tribal Governance (8 credits)

Tribal Governance concentration students must complete at least 2 of the following 5 concentration courses:

- Path to Sovereignty (4 credits)**
- Intergovernmental Relations (4 credits)**
- Tribal Organizations (4 credits)**
- Tribal Economics (4 credits)**
- Tribal Policy (4 credits)**

### Electives (16 credits total)

Elective courses are either 2 credit or 4 credit courses. In addition to MPA elective offerings, an MPA Tribal Governance student may earn elective credits through a combination of the following options:

- Tribal concentration courses beyond the two required to earn the concentration
- Evergreen Master of Environmental Studies elective courses;
- Individual Learning Contracts (each ILC cannot exceed 4 credits);
- Internship Contracts (up to 4 credits); or
- Graduate courses transferred from other institutions (with approval of MPA Director).
