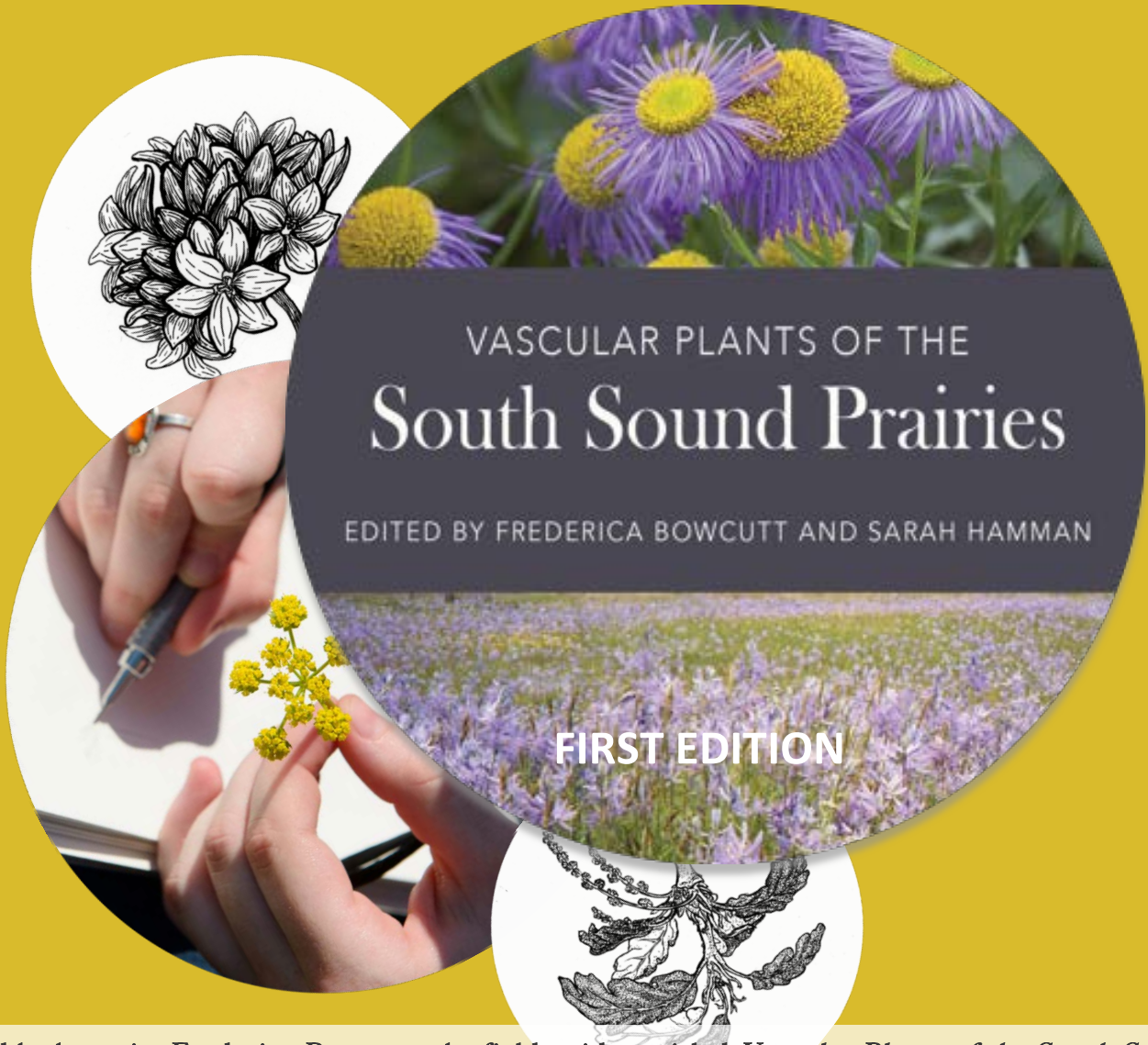


BOOK LAUNCH

Headed by botanist Frederica Bowcutt, the field guide entitled *Vascular Plants of the South Sound Prairies* has been thirteen years in the making, involving over forty students from the Evergreen State College as well as scientists from Evergreen, Centralia College, and the Center for Natural Lands Management. This first edition includes illustrations and descriptions of nearly 150 plants found in glacial outwash prairies from Tacoma to Rochester, Washington, as well as descriptions of the climate, geology, vegetation, restoration ecology, and sensitive species associated with these endangered ecosystems.
