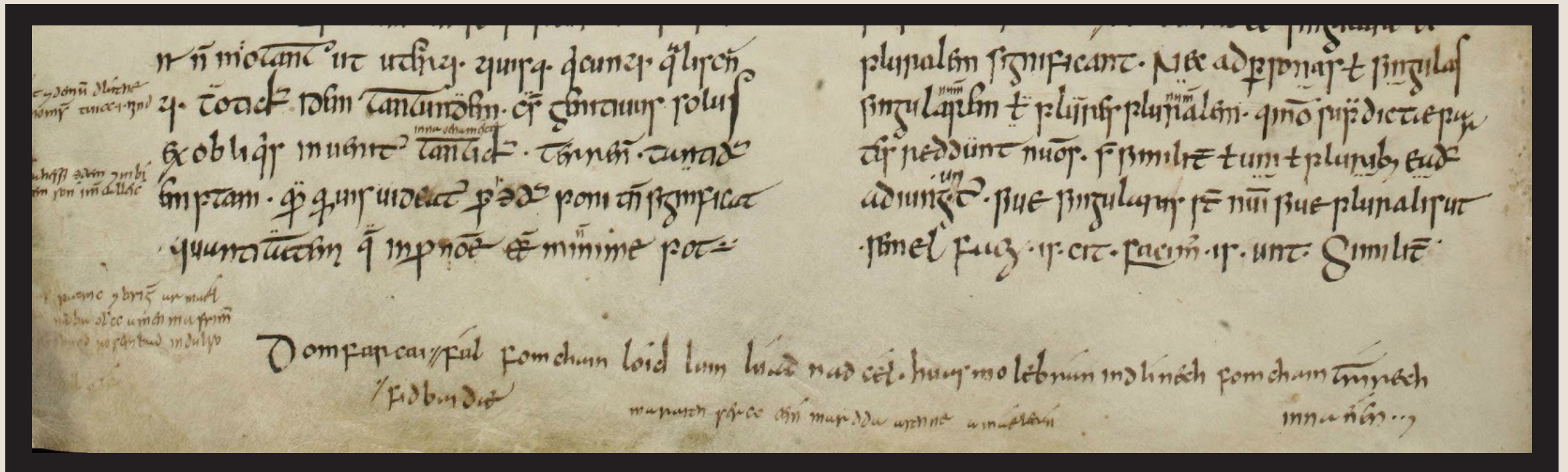


LIMINALITY
