Celebrations like Kupala Night and Maslenitsa have been adapted from traditional pagan holidays to fit a newer Christian context. Though the reasons for celebration have changed, the rites and activities remain largely the same.

## TBOEBBOMB Dual Fin Russia

The maintenance of pagan beliefs through dual faith traditions has paved the way for Slavic neopagan movements. Unfortunately, many of these revivals have a heavy note of ethno-nationalism, and as such some symbols have been removed from their original context and co-opted by far-right groups.
